

Itinerary

Day

You will be picked up from the airport and taken to your hotel. In the evening, join the whole group and your guide for complimentary drinks, welcome briefing, and an orientation before your first group meal.

Day 2

Time to explore the marina and old town centre in the morning. Board the catamaran for your first trip in the afternoon. Your on board guide will provide in-depth information about the wildlife, discuss the sightings, share details on current research and help you get the best shots of the whales! First group audio-visual presentation after your boat trip with marine biologist guide.

Days 3-4

Each day there will be a morning and afternoon boat trip. The exact itinerary is decided by guides upon arrival to optimise your chance of sightings.

Day 5

You will be collected from your hotel this morning for a full day tour to the village of Furnas where you will learn about the volcanic history of the island and local culture. You will enjoy bathing in rmineral rich geothermal hot springs set in award winning botanical gardens. You will also sample the traditional "Cozido" at lunch time in a local restaurant – a meat or vegetable stew cooked geothermally underground.

Day 6

There will be opportunities for additional island excursions and more trips to sea to fit with your program. You will have time to explore the local lava caves, pineapple plantations and stunning botanical gardens.

Day 7

An opportunity to add more trips to sea or land tours. Final presentation by your marine biologist guide followed by group farewell meal. Afterwards, you will have the opportunity to share photos with the group and discuss highlights of the holiday over a celebratory drink in the bar.

Day 8

Departure day. Transfer to airport from hotel.

This incredible tour runs in April/May as this is the best time for seeing migratory Blue Whales off the Azores. Your base will be the Azorean island of Pico, a third of which is a nature reserve, with a volcano at its core.

The main focus of the week is to see Blue Whales of course, and you will have exclusive guide services with talks and audio visual presentations from Oceanographer and marine science researcher, Russell Arnott of Incredible Oceans. You will have a chance to become totally immersed in the whale research process during your time there, learning about data collection, whale behaviour, feeding habits and also get to hear the sounds of the Blue Whale using hydrophones. Our guests are always blown away and inspired by the expert marine biologist knowledge as well as their commitment to responsible whale watching.

Russell Arnott has a passion for marine science and ocean conservation. He is a unique and engaging presenter and has specific knowledge of the marine life and the fascinating geological origin of the Azores Islands. He is a published author and wrote "Ocean Endangered" which explores marine conservation issues and offers guidance to individuals who want to take action and make a difference. He also runs a marine conservation charity called Incredible Oceans and currently teaches marine science at University level.





Itimerar

Day 1 - Upon arriving in the Azores, you will be transferred to the hotel for a welcome briefing and introductions. Enjoy complimentary drinks and an orientation of the local area. Rest up before discussing the schedule of whale-watching boat trips and meeting oceanographer Russell Arnott during the welcome dinner with your group in the evening.

Day 2 - Begin the day with a briefing from our marine biologist before boarding the RIB Zodiac for a morning of whale-watching. Throughout the week, there will be audio-visual presentations about the Azores' whales and dolphins, including the history of whaling and whale-watching in the region. Your onboard guide will offer detailed insights into the wildlife, assist in capturing the best shots of the whales, and engage in discussions about the sightings. In the afternoon, visit the local "Vigia," the lookout who spots the whales and guides the boat's skipper.

Days 3 to 6 - Each morning, embark on a boat trip, adjusted according to weather conditions. Enjoy additional opportunities for excursions around the island between your five half-day sea trips, such as exploring the Gruta de Torres underground lava caves. In case of any weather disruptions, our guides will reschedule your trips for the best weather and conditions. Attend talks and presentations by experts to deepen your knowledge about the Azores' whales, other wildlife, geology, local history, and culture.

Day 7 - Explore the island's beauty and charm on a full-day tour, learning about the local culture, volcanic origins, and visiting the UNESCO world heritage vineyards. Lunch at the vineyard includes local produce and a wine tasting experience. Evening Meal with your guide brings the trip to a close.

Day 8 - On departure day, transfer to the airport from your hotel.
